We will be learning through the seven areas of our curriculum.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- ◇ Use a calendar to find and record our birthdays.
- ◇ Researching the Firework Code.
- ◇ How to keep safe in the dark.

Communication and Language

- ◇ Celebrations role-play.
- ◇ Following a sequence of oral instructions to wrap a birthday present.
- ◇ Talking about our experiences of celebrations extending our sentences by using joining words.

Physical Development

- ◇ Firework dancing.
- ◇ Developing independent dressing skills; PE kit, coats, hats, scarves and gloves.
- ◇ Building 3d fireworks using tubes, pegs, clips, elastic bands.

Literacy

- ◇ List making - planning the best birthday ever!
- ◇ Re-telling the Christmas story.
- ◇ Developing the use of adjectives in our spoken and written work.

Mathematics

- ◇ Naming and describing 3d shape Christmas presents.
- ◇ Naming the months of the year.
- ◇ Understanding and using the language of more and less in Christmas problem solving.
