### **DINNER AND MILK MONEY**

A reminder that dinner money is £2.30 per day (£11.50 a week). If you would like your children to have milk, the cost of this is £13.30 for the term. At St. Bart's, we operate a cashless payment system and we therefore ask that all payments are made through Agora. If you do not have login details to access this, please ask at the school office.

### **SCHOOL FUND**

Thank you to those families who have provided school fund donations which will help to provide a whole range of extra resources and activities for our children. (Recommended donation of £5 per child - £10 for three or more children).

### **MORNING ACCESS TO SCHOOL**

In the interests of ensuring your child's health and safety when arriving at school in the morning, please could I remind you that the gates are open between 8.45 and 9.00am. Please ensure that children access the school through the school gates and enter via the appropriate entrance. All parents are politely reminded that lessons begin at 9.00am and at this time the gates will be locked. Any child arriving after this time, should access the school through the main entrance and sign in at reception. We thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

### **PE KITS**

Please ensure that your child has an indoor and warm outdoor kit in school each day. It is essential that children have a pair of trainers with a good grip for outdoor games.

### **JEWELLERY**

Can I please remind all parents that, in accordance with the school uniform policy, children should not wear any jewellery to school (excluding watches and recognised jewellery worn for religious purposes). This includes all earrings. Please ensure that all jewellery is removed before coming to school. Children will be asked to remove jewellery and teachers will keep this safe until the end of the school day.
